How do I link a manager to the biosphere reserve?

How do I add a project?

First you need to log-in as either a Biosphere Reserve manager or a researcher. Then, click on the "add a project" tab in the menu drawer.

- Country*

- Description

What are Events?

Events are planned activities that are happening within the Biosphere Reserve. Only Biosphere Reserve Managers can add events

How do I add an Event?

To add an event, you first need to log-in as a biosphere reserve manager. Then, click on the "events page" in the menu drawer and click on "add an event".

What are publications?

Publications are scientific research done by various scientists. Our website only contains publications done in Biosphere Reserves.

How do I add a publication?

To add a publication, you first need to login. Then, click on "Add a publication" that is available within the publication section of the website.

You need the following information:

- Publication Title*
- Publication Type*
- Country
- Biosphere Reserve
- Year of Publication*
- Language
- Journal
- DOI (Digital Object Identifier)
- Tags
- External links
- Authors (several authors can be added)
